Note on expenses: The aging heating infrastructure of our church has needed a number of repairs, and upgrades this year – plus normal maintenance. This accounts for about \$8,000 of the expenses to date. Giving to date is comparable to last year.

All students applying were found to be well qualified and are receiving a scholarship award from one or more of the three funds Community Church has been entrusted with. The grand total awarded will be \$27,700, using a combination of the Laude, Myers, and Liebetreu funds. We will recognize the students during worship and at Coffee Hour on Sunday, June 1st.
